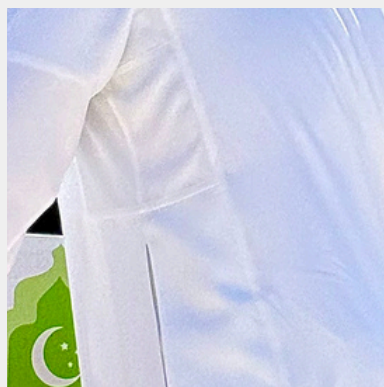
World Disability Day with Our Special Friends

Volunteer day

Next year, we are planning to formally have one volunteer day every month (except during the summer) with the different charities we partner with. We also plan to launch our own volunteer program by the end of 2026.

The ASJ Tribute



In April 2026, we will hold a tribute to the life of our father, Abdulrahman Sulaiman bin Jebreen, honoring all the good deeds he carried out during his lifetime. We will invite the people of Quwaiiya to the mosque to share a meal and learn more about what he did and what we continue to do in his name.



Future leaders program

This project aims to identify outstanding high school students and support them through mentorships, sponsorships for conferences or courses that help them achieve their career goals, as well as provide them with a one-year scholarship so they can focus on their studies.

Community Impact Shark Tank



A competition designed to foster innovation, social impact, and community development by allowing individuals and teams to pitch projects that address key societal challenges. These projects must focus on solving a problem in the community, supporting vulnerable groups, enhancing education through innovation, or promoting sustainability.



Universal accessibility project

This initiative aims to finance and implement infrastructure improvements to make public spaces more accessible for people with disabilities. The focus will be to start with our mosque and then reach out to public places in Quwaiiya that need it the most.
