

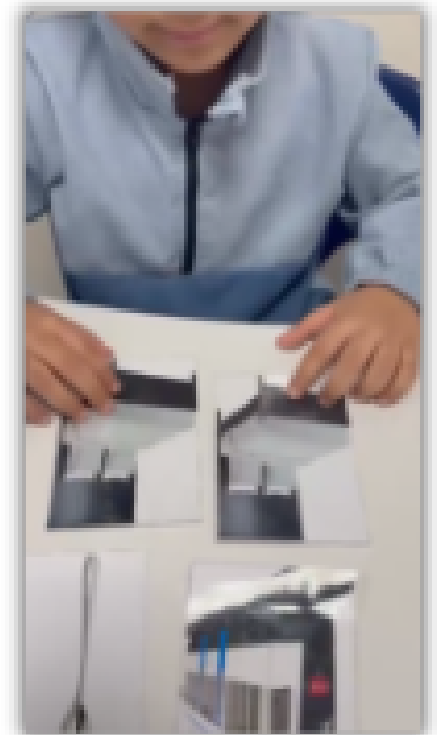


During Q1 2026, ASJF Foundation continued to strengthen its impact through strategic partnerships, targeted social initiatives, and community engagement. Key efforts focused on advancing inclusive employment programs, supporting vulnerable groups through healthcare and social assistance initiatives, and expanding outreach during Ramadan through large-scale Iftar distribution and community gatherings. In parallel, the Foundation reinforced its ecosystem of partners, ensuring alignment, transparency, and sustainable collaboration. These efforts collectively reflect our commitment to delivering measurable impact while building a strong foundation for continued growth in the year ahead.

Detailed Activities

Partnership with Autism Center of Excellence

During Q1, we established a partnership with ACE (Autism Center of Excellence) to sponsor four individuals enrolled in its **employment training program**. The initiative provides SAR 2,000 per beneficiary per month, totaling SAR 8,000 monthly and **SAR 24,000** in Q1. This collaboration reflects our commitment to advancing inclusive workforce development by equipping individuals with autism with practical skills for long-term independence.

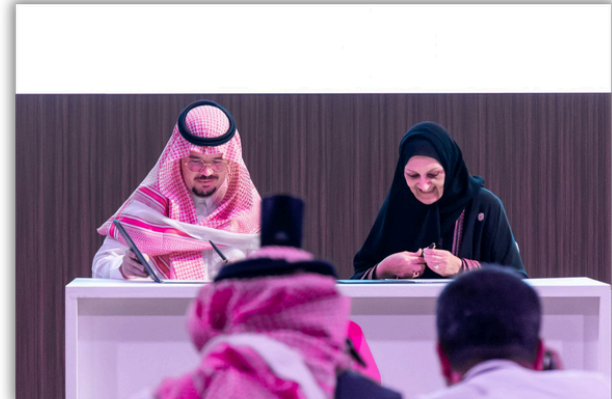
Partnership with Our Special Friends

During Q1, we strengthened our partnership with Our Special Friends, supporting **five individuals enrolled in the employment training program**. As part of this initiative, we are funding participants' salaries for a six-month period, with a total contribution of **SAR 30,000** recorded during the first quarter. This collaboration reflects our continued commitment to fostering inclusive employment opportunities and empowering individuals through sustainable skill development.



Partnership with Zahra Association

We reinforced our partnership with Zahra Breast Cancer Association by contributing **SAR 9,000** to a patient sponsorship initiative **supporting women undergoing breast cancer treatment**. The program provides essential psychosocial and rehabilitative support throughout their treatment journey.





Partnership with SANAD

During Q1, we also formalized a partnership with Sanad to support a range of social programs, including **food voucher distribution during Ramadan, family sponsorship, winter clothing support, recreational initiatives, and psychosocial engagement programs for children.** The Q1 contribution totalled **SAR 24,000**, comprising SAR 21,000 allocated to food vouchers during Ramadan and SAR 3,000 for family sponsorship (SAR 1,000 per month). In addition, a **hospital visit initiative for children with cancer** was conducted, involving entertainment activities such as a live show, games, meals, and gift distribution; this initiative was funded separately , with a budget of **SAR 6,000.**

Sufrat Al Khair dinners

In January, we successfully hosted our **Sufrat Al Khair Dinne**, bringing together our community of supporters to strengthen engagement and raise awareness of the Foundation's mission. The event served as a platform to reflect on our impact, share key achievements, and reinforce our commitment to expanding our reach.





Mosque Maintenance

During Q1, we continued to prioritize **the maintenance and enhancement of the mosque** through a series of operational and infrastructure improvements. These included the execution of an annual maintenance contract covering mosque operations and staffing, the preparation of the mortuary washing facility funded from generated income, and renovation works such as painting, plumbing upgrades, AC cleaning, and general maintenance. Additional enhancements included the installation of chairs in waiting areas, the placement of an external water tank in compliance with municipality requirements, and the installation of a glass partition between the mosque and funeral rooms, along with additional seating. Furthermore, approval was granted for the monthly procurement of three tanks of desalinated water to improve water quality for both the mortuary and mosque. The total cost for these works amounted to **SAR 92,641.63**.





ICSDI 2026

We attended the inauguration of the 3rd International Conference on Sustainability **ICSDI 2026** in collaboration with Prince Sultan University. This engagement reflects our ongoing commitment to participating in platforms that promote knowledge exchange, sustainability, and social impact.



Ramadan Activities

Sufrat Al Khair - Ramadan special

During Ramadan, we hosted **four special Sufrat Al Khair dinners**, providing a platform to share updates on our ongoing projects, partnerships, and key initiatives. These gatherings strengthened engagement with our community and reinforced transparency around our impact. **One of the dinners was dedicated exclusively to our partners**, focusing on aligning strategic objectives for 2026 and identifying opportunities to further strengthen our collaboration and long-term relationships.





Ramadan Activities

Iftar meals

During Ramadan, we distributed **7,305 Iftar meals at the mosque**, achieving a record number of meals shared and marking a significant milestone in our outreach efforts. This accomplishment reflects the strength of our operational capacity and the continued support of our community and partners, with a total cost of **SAR 73,050**.



Kebar dinner

As part of our ongoing commitment to strengthening strategic partnerships, we had the opportunity to attend **Kebar's Ramadan celebration dinner**. Kebar is a key partner in our Hajj program, and this engagement reflects our efforts to reinforce collaboration, foster mutual trust, and ensure the continued success and expansion of our joint initiatives.

In Q2, we will continue advancing our ongoing projects with our partners: **ACE, SANAD, Our Special Friends, and Zahra,** ensuring continuity and sustained impact across all initiatives. Additionally, we will host a Sufrat Al Khair gathering during the quarter, bringing our partners together to review progress, align expectations, and jointly define priorities for the second half of the year, further strengthening collaboration and strategic alignment.
