



During Q2 2026, ASJF Foundation continued to strengthen its impact by expanding strategic partnerships, fostering collaboration across the nonprofit sector, and advancing initiatives that support children with special needs. Throughout the quarter, the Foundation reinforced existing partnerships, expanded its network through key sector events and strategic engagements, and continued promoting a collaborative ecosystem focused on sustainable social impact. The successful hosting of our 2nd Sufrat Al Khair Dinner with Partners further strengthened relationships, aligned shared priorities, increased awareness of the Foundation's mission, and reinforced our contribution to the goals of Saudi Vision 2030.

Detailed Activities

Partnership with SANAD

During Q2, we continued strengthening our partnership with SANAD by supporting a range of social programs, including family sponsorship, recreational initiatives, and psychosocial engagement programs for children. During the quarter, our contribution totaled **SAR 3,000** for **family sponsorship (SAR 1,000 per month)**. This ongoing collaboration reflects our shared commitment to improving the well-being of vulnerable families and children through sustainable, community-focused initiatives.



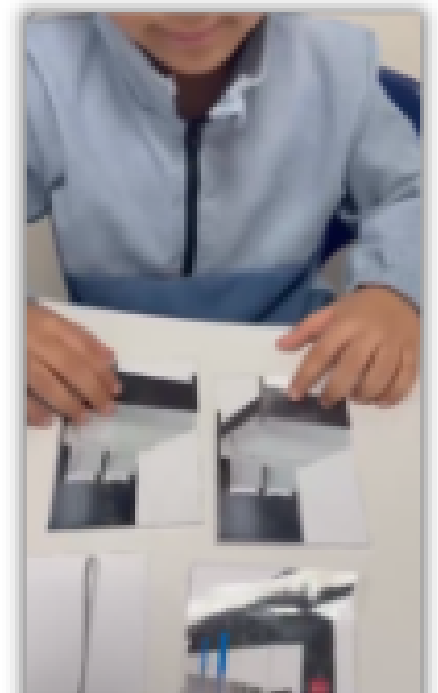

Partnership with Autism Center of Excellence

During Q2, we continued our partnership with **ACE** (Autism Center of Excellence), maintaining our sponsorship of four individuals enrolled in its employment training program. Through this ongoing initiative, we provided **SAR 2,000 per beneficiary** per month, totaling **SAR 8,000 monthly** and **SAR 24,000 during Q2**. By continuing this collaboration, we further strengthened our shared commitment to advancing inclusive workforce development and equipping individuals with autism with the practical skills needed for long-term independence.



Additionally, during Q2, the Foundation proudly attended **the Excellence Gala of the Autism Center of Excellence**, where **we were honored with an award** in recognition of our valued partnership and continued support. The event celebrated the achievements of individuals with autism and highlighted the impact of collaborative efforts in advancing inclusion, employment opportunities, and long-term empowerment. Receiving this recognition reinforces our commitment to building meaningful partnerships that create lasting social impact.

As part of this ongoing initiative, we continued funding the participants' salaries, with a total contribution of **SAR 30,000 during Q2**. This collaboration reflects our sustained commitment to fostering inclusive employment opportunities, empowering individuals through meaningful work experience, and creating lasting social impact through long-term partnerships.



In addition to our ongoing partnership with Our Special Friends, during Q2 the Foundation attended the **Association's annual closing ceremony**, where we were honored with a **recognition award** in appreciation of our continued support and collaboration. The event also provided a valuable opportunity to strengthen relationships with sector partners, celebrate the impact achieved together, and reaffirm our shared commitment to advancing the inclusion and empowerment of individuals with disabilities.

Mosque Maintenance

During Q2, we continued to prioritize the maintenance and enhancement of the mosque through ongoing operational and infrastructure improvements. These included the continuation of the annual maintenance contract covering mosque operations and staffing, as well as renovation and upkeep works such as painting, plumbing upgrades, air conditioning maintenance, and general repairs to ensure the facility remains safe, functional, and welcoming for worshippers. The total cost for these works during Q2 amounted to SAR 91,119.8.

During Q2, we continued strengthening our commitment to expanding the Foundation's network and building meaningful relationships across the nonprofit sector. As a result of these efforts, I received an invitation to become a member of the Down Syndrome Charitable Association (DSCA) General Assembly.
